<b>Programme Fees</b>	\$15 if paid by 16 September for 24 September or \$20 if paid 17 September or later \$15 if paid by 21 October for 29 October or \$20 if paid 22 October or later Programme Fees include programme materials.
<b>Target Audience</b>	Girls who are Beginners to Advanced, aged 7 – 16
<b>Programme Details</b>	Each Session will include individual and group coaching, tournament preparation and playing games. The primary focus will be on engendering confidence in playing Chess.
<b>Materials</b>	None required
<b>Venue</b>	The Programme will be held at the International School of Tucson
<b>Instructor</b>	The Instructor will be Tucson Chess Centre Director Ms Jessica Martin
<b>Payment</b>	All Programme Fees must be paid in full before the Programme begins. The Programme and student enrolments will not be confirmed until payment is received.
<b>Payment Methods</b>	Payments should be made by cheque payable to “Sixth Avenue Tutorials”. Any cheques returned unpaid for whatever reason will incur a \$25 “Returned Cheque Fee” and the amount of the cheque plus this fee shall become immediately payable in cash.
<b>Participant Numbers</b>	A minimum of four and a maximum of sixteen participants is required for each Session. Enrolment will be on a “first come, first served” basis and where more students are interested than are places available, a Waiting List will be established. A student who registers and then cancels or fails to attend can only receive a refund if his/her place is filled by another student.
